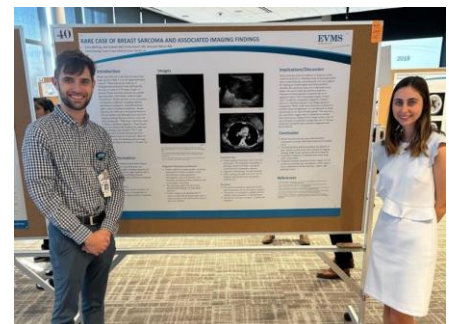

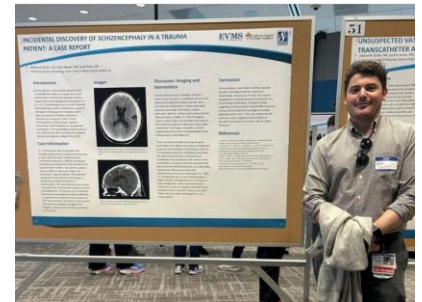

UPDATE ON ENDOWED LECTURES, FUNDRAISING, AND RESIDENT EDUCATION SUPPORT:

-Ninth Annual Tapan K. Chaudhuri, MD Endowed Lecture in Nuclear Medicine:

Ninth is pending, TBA. Lester Johnson, MD, PhD, FACR, Professor and Chair of Radiology at EVMS was honored to be the Eighth Chaudhuri Lecturer.

-Tenth Annual Reverend Anne C. Brower, M.D. Lectureships in Musculoskeletal Radiology:

In 2014 we were grieved by the death of the Reverend Anne C. Brower, MD, our esteemed and renowned former EVMS Chair of Radiology and Residency Program Director. A memorial was published in the RSNA News Oct-Nov 2014 (Vol 24 issues 10 & 11).

In honor of Dr. Brower, our Dept. of Radiology raised money to create a permanent endowed lectureship (supporting a Visiting Professor Day for the residents) at EVMS in musculoskeletal radiology. The process of creating the endowment began before Anne’s death and pleased her greatly, she expressed much gratitude.

Thanks to support from numerous residency Alumni and current/former Faculty members who remember Dr. Brower, plus admirers from other institutions, >50 contributors, our fundraising campaign succeeded in our goal of raising >\$100,000 for this wonderful endowment which is now fully funded. Thank you!

The Tenth Annual Brower Lecture was given in the spring of 2023 by Yulia Melenevsky, MD, Assistant Professor and Musculoskeletal Imaging Fellowship Program Director at the University of Alabama Medical College,

Birmingham, Alabama. Dr. Melenevsky's highly educational Visiting Professor Day was attended and loved by residents from both EVMS and NMCP.

-Residency Education Fund:

In 2013 we launched the first annual fundraising campaign asking residency Alumni for support of training for the current residents, which continues as an annual appeal. The Fund is to help with the kinds of expenses not covered by the GME budget, such as the cost of sending residents to attend national meetings to present research.

In the past 10 years, several current and former Faculty leaders of the program have offered combined matching funds of over \$4,000 each year if Alumni donated. I am delighted to report that Alumni (and others) have been donating! In the past ten years at least 62 people have contributed a total of \$152,045, which includes \$19,600 this past year! Thank you so much! Please consider giving generously to the annual residency education fund—it has a huge positive impact on our residents!

Our residents are aware of this awesome support and are very appreciative, as you can imagine. The Alumni support has been fantastic for the residents, enhancing their research efforts and education (details of how the money helps are in this year's fundraising letter).

Other departments at EVMS have endowed professorships, including three other private practice departments--the Departments of Pediatrics, Urology, and Emergency Medicine.

Last year Radiology launched a campaign to raise funds to endow our own professorship!

When it is fully funded, the proceeds of the endowment will go to support the same kinds of expenses as the Radiology Residency Education Fund, but in the form of a permanent endowment in support of our residents' education and scholarly activity.

Great news! Thanks to the amazing generosity and support of our radiologists, including some wonderful friends of EVMS Radiology Residency who are retired former Chairs of EVMS Radiology and leaders of MCR, we have already received a tremendous show of support in the first year of this campaign!
