HIP AND THIGH

General

Evaluate hip and anterior thigh with patient supine
 Evaluate posterior thigh with patient prone
 Patient rolls to contralateral side for evaluation of greater trochanter
 Complete examination versus focused evaluation of area of pain
 Transverse and longitudinal images as indicated

 Joint capsule

 Gluteus minimus tendon
 Gluteus medius tendon
 Iliotibial tract
